\_\_\_\_\_ at least 3 credits psychobiology (e.g., 704, 710)

\_\_\_\_\_ at least 3 credits social/developmental psychology (e.g., 700, 702)

\_\_\_\_\_ at least 3 credits applied psychology (e.g., 611)

\_\_\_\_\_ no more than 3 credits psychology independent study or special topics

\_\_\_\_\_ no more than 3 credits outside psychology

\_\_\_\_\_ 2 statistics courses (total 6 credits) beyond Psyc209/609^

\_\_\_\_\_ 2 core courses (total 6 credits) (i.e., courses number 700 -710)

\*Note: Some courses fulfill multiple requirements (e.g., Psyc702 meets the requirement of one core course, but also satisfies the social/developmental distribution requirement.)

^Psyc209/609 previously held the numbers 212/667

**Other requirements:**

\_\_\_\_\_ No grade below B- among the 30 credits counted toward the degree

\_\_\_\_\_ 3.0 grade point average among the 30 credits counted toward the degree

\_\_\_\_\_ No more than 6 credits counting toward both the Bachelor's and Master's degree

\_\_\_\_\_ No more than 6 credits taken as an overload during undergraduate studies to count toward the Master's degree
